

Coopers' Cask – Inter Company Competition

All scoring to be loosely **based on** the Mullens and Maydwell Trophies

The following categories have been deleted:-

Orienteering (subsumed into sports), Discretionary (expanded into better defined categories).

The following categories have been introduced:

Community Engagement: community work that attracts a written commendation from a community leader
Public Relations: press coverage that relates to any detachment activity
Charity Collections: fund raising for any charitable concern. The scoring has been biased towards the Army Benevolent Fund because this is the ACFA chosen charity

Scoring to be quarterly for the following categories:-

APC Points, Course Points, Charity Collections, Community Engagement, Public Relations

Scores will be published quarterly on a running total basis.

Scoring to be calculated annually in Q4 for all other categories as some criteria can only be assessed at certain times of the year (e.g. Age Structure, Recruiting, Annual Inspections, Attendance at Annual Camp and various competitions).

D of E Passes, BTEC Passes, Sports Points, County Colours, Cadet Ages, Cadet Recruitment, Annual Inspection Grades, Annual Camp Attendance, Poppy Appeal Results.

Reporting periods will be as follows:

September to November, December to February, March to May and June to August ending during Annual Camp.

Scores will be reported on a Detachment basis but will be calculated to give a Company total.

In each category points will be awarded by Company as follows:

Highest total	25 points
2 nd	20 points
3 rd	15 points
4 th	10 points
5 th	5 points

No points will be awarded for Companies without a score in a category.

Using the APC assessment scoring criteria as an example; if the scoring were as follows at the end of the first Quarter the competition points awarded would be as shown:

Note:- These are the points awarded as per the rules e.g. in this example a Detachment that attained 7 x one star passes, 4 x two star passes, 3 x three star passes, 1 x four star and 1x master cadet pass would score as follows:-

One star: 7 x 1 points = 7
Two star: 4 x 2 points = 8
Three star: 3 x 4 points = 12
Four star: 1 x 6 points = 6
Master Cadet: 1 x 8 points = 8
TOTAL POINTS = 41
